



Northstar Community Service District Green Waste Recycling Center

The Northstar Community Service District green waste recycling center and curbside pick-up program will be in operation **Thursday May 4th, 2017 until Friday October 6th, 2017**. Residential curbside pick-up will be on **Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, only**. Please do not put any material out before May 4th or after October 6th.

In order to assist district staff we ask that you follow these few simple guidelines when leaving material curbside in front of your property:

Acceptable Curb-Side Material:

- Contractors, working on Northstar resident properties are **encouraged** to take any amount of slash or pine needles directly to the green waste recycling center. Homeowners and contractors using the recycling lot must pick up a daily access key at the Northstar Fire Station #31, 910 Northstar Drive.
- Pine needles, 10 bags maximum at any given time, bags must be free from rocks, dirt or other foreign debris.
- Slash Piles: Maximum 4'x 4' x 4' piles only.
- Slash Piles may consist of the following: Tree limbs, branches, and wood lengths. Tree bark, old firewood, and tree rounds are acceptable providing the material is stacked in an organized manner and can be lifted by one person.

Please **No**:

- Grass clippings.
- Dirt, rock, or other foreign debris.

The green waste recycling facility will be open during normal business hours, Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
