ORDINANCE NO. 32-16

**ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 31-16
DROUGHT EMERGENCY WATER
CONSERVATION MEASURES**

AS A BASIS AND PREMISE for this Ordinance, the Board of Directors (“Board”) of the Northstar Community Services District (“District”) finds as follows:

1. In 2014, 2015 and most recently on March 23, 2016 in Urgency Ordinance 31-16, this Board adopted ordinances implementing emergency water conservation measures consistent with regulations of the California State Water Resources Control Board (“SWRCB”).

2. On May 18, 2016 SWRCB adopted amended *Drought Emergency Water Conservation* regulations (“May 2016 Emergency Regulations”) which became effective on June 1, 2016, and which removed requirements previously applicable to the District to limit outdoor irrigation of ornamental landscapes or turf with potable water or reduce potable water production by 25 percent when compared to water production in 2013.

3. The May 2016 Emergency Regulations still impose certain statewide water-use prohibitions and regulations that are applicable to District water customers, and which are enforced by SWRCB or other state officials.

4. Enforcement and oversight of the water use restrictions noted in Recital 2 placed a significant administrative and operational burden on District personnel.

5. Notwithstanding the elimination of the water use restrictions noted in Recital 2, the District continues to implement an array of water conservation measures, including real-time collection and dissemination of water customer meter readings, intensive leak detection and notification programs, consumption based rates, *et cetera*.

6. In view of the foregoing, Urgency Ordinance 31-16 is unnecessary and should be repealed.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Northstar Community Services District as follows:

1. The above Recitals are all true and correct.

2. Ordinance 31-16, *Urgency Ordinance Adopting 2016 Drought Emergency Water Conservation Measures* is hereby repealed in its entirety, effective immediately.

3. The President of the Board (or, in his absence, the Vice President) shall sign this Ordinance and the Secretary shall attest to the President's or Vice President's signature. The Secretary shall then publish this Ordinance, and the Secretary may post a certified copy of it in the District office, within 15 days after its passage. After publication, the Secretary shall enter a copy of his certificate attesting to the publication, and, if applicable, posting, in the Minutes of the Board.


